CHECKLIST

1. CONTACT LES RÉSIDENCES FUNÉRAIRES GOYER (24/7)

The funeral director will take the necessary measures to pick up the remains. You will then set an appointment in order to plan the details of the funeral, which include:

- The date, location, length and type of tribute paid to the remains
- Religious or secular ceremony
- Funeral proceedings
- Type and location of burial

2. WHAT YOU MUST BRING TO YOUR APPOINTMENT

- Clothing, undergarments and socks (excluding shoes) of the deceased
- Glasses and dental prostheses
- Makeup (lipstick, nail polish, etc.)
- Jewellery and personal items to place in the casket
- Recent photograph
- Health Insurance Card, Social Insurance Card and other official documents (birth certificate, marriage certificate)
- List of those left in mourning to be mentioned in the obituary

3. WHAT CAN BE HANDLED BY THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR

- Ordering floral arrangements
- Booking the reception hall
- Recommending and supervising a caterer
- Providing information regarding the purchase and engraving of a monument
- Preparing thank-you cards or bookmarks

4. WE ASSIST YOU IN DEALING WITH GOVERNMENT PAPERWORK

- Form from the Directeur de l'état civil for a copy of the act of death
- Québec Pension plan form
- Old Age Security form

- Declaring the death to the Directeur de l'état civil
- Cancelling the Health Insurance Card
- Submitting the attestation of death to settle the succession



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
